The stated meeting of June 15th was to be a field day planning and work session. We will be setting up for field day on Friday, June 24 at W8TUY's farm.

A work day was planned for June 18th to mow Frank's (W8TUY) grass and clean up for field day.

W0OZZ moved to adopt the Logo, designed by Mike Armstrong, as the "Official" club logo. This motion was seconded by Jim, KA8JIM. Without discussion, this motion was unanimously passed.

No further business appearing, the meeting was adjourned at 8:14 PM. The attendees enjoyed the usual coffee and doughnuts.
