

Field Day 2020 Screening Checklist for Visitors & Workers

These Canton ARC guidelines are based on recent input from CDC and ODH.

Measure visitor's forehead temperature. The tool will indicate PASS-FAIL. Deny access if FAIL is indicated. Re-measure in a few minutes, the individual may have been exerting. Make certain it is set to measure human tissue, not surface temperatures.

Ask these questions to all visitors upon site entry....

1. Since your last visit to this activity, have you experienced any of these conditions (that are not attributable to another condition)?

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

2. Since your last visit to this activity, have you experienced two or more of these conditions (that are not attributable to another condition)?

- Fever
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Nausea
- Vomiting

3. Have you traveled outside Ohio in the last 14 days, or have you had close contact in the last 14 days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19?

Affirmative answers to any of the above should be brought to the attention of the BSO and access denied until the situation is reviewed.
